Supervisor Mark Farrell requests a hearing at the Government, Audit and Oversight committee to examine the proposed CCA contract with Shell Energy North America, as well as the proposed \$19.5 million appropriation to fund start-up costs for the program commonly referred to as CleanPowerSF.

Specifically Supervisor Farrell will inquire into the following issues:

Green Jobs:

- If there is no requirement for new renewable energy projects in the contract and there is an expected job loss due to the program start-up cost of \$19.5 million, how is the City going to make up for the lost jobs?
- To pay for this new, unproven program, the PUC is cutting successful green jobs programs (like GoSolarSF and the city's job-creating energy efficiency programs). Why cut proven job-creating programs to pay for an untested program that creates no new green jobs?

Green Energy:

- If there is no requirement for new renewable energy projects in the contract, how can it be guaranteed that new renewable energy will be created and greenhouse gasses will be reduced?

Compliance with State Law:

- California State law mandates that by 2020 California utilities must procure at least 33% renewable energy, but this contract requires only 10% renewable energy. What is the plan -- and what are the associated costs -- to procure enough renewable energy to comply with California state law?

Costs:

- The program start-up cost is \$19.5 million. Rate increases by the PUC to pay for the CleanPowerSF program will hit City General Fund departments such as the Recreation and Park Department, the Fire Department, and other entities such as SFUSD and San Francisco Community College District (to name a few) and will have a negative impact on their budgets when they are already suffering from budget cuts. What is the total cost increase to each department and impact to their budgets?

Definition of 100 percent renewable:

- What does 100 percent renewable mean if CleanPowerSF will rely on 85% "firmed and shaped" energy that is created by Shell Oil's fossil fuels?
