12	WHEREAS, Southwest Airlines' short-term plans include an increase	e in the number of	
13	daily flights requiring them to add additional counter space and baggage ha	andling equipment	
14	to accommodate passenger loads; and,		
15	WHEREAS, The US Department of Homeland Security /Transportat	ion Security	
16	Administration (TSA) has indicated that it will reimburse the Airport approxi	mately 75% of the	
17	eligible project cost not to exceed \$2,300,000 for these devices but will only allocate funds to		
18	the Airport; and,		
19	WHEREAS, San Francisco International Airport will reimburse South	nwest Airlines for	
20	the baggage handling system with in-line explosive detection systems work equal to the		
21	amount it receives from the TSA; and,		
22	WHEREAS, the installation of these devices will ensure the continua	ation of the Airport's	
23	policy that all outbound baggage is electronically screened for explosive devices; and,		
24	WHEREAS On September 4, 2007, pursuant to Resolution No. 07-0215, the Airport		
25	Commission authorized the Airport Director to execute an Other Transaction	n Agreement with

1	TSA to expand, reconfigure and implement in-line explosive detection systems in Terminal				
2	One and authorized the Airport Director to enter into a Reimbursable Agreement with				
3	Southwest Airlines; and,				
4	WHEREAS, The grant does not require ASO amendment; and,				
5	WHEREAS, The Airport proposes to maximize the use of available grant funds on				
6	program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it				
7	RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the Other				
8	Transaction Agreement between the Airport and the Transportation Security Administration to				
9	expand, reconfigure and implement in-line explosive detection systems in Terminal One and				
10	authorizes the Airport to accept and expend TSA funding; and be it				
11	FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of				
12	indirect costs in the grant budget.
