Michael Maffei's application for appointment to the Veterans Commission

Qualifications:

I served on active duty in the United States Navy from January, 2006 until August, 2010. In that 4 and a half year time period, I deployed to Baghdad, Iraq, as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom, for six months from December 2006 until June 2007. Additionally, during my time in the Navy, I practiced as a military criminal litigator and legal assistance attorney. In that capacity, I handled a wide range of legal matters both criminal and civil in nature.

I started my career as a Navy public defender and legal assistance attorney at Naval Base Ventura County. I defended service members at administrative hearings and in misdemeanor and felony trials. At the same time, I provided general legal advice in the areas of landlord/tenant law, immigration law, veterans' benefits, tax law, creditor/debtor matters, civilian criminal law, and basic estate planning.

Following my Ventura County assignment, I transferred to Washington, D.C., where I worked as a law clerk to an appellate court judge on the Navy-Marine Corps Court of Criminal Appeals. In April, 2009, I transferred to the Appellate Defense Division, where I defended service members on appeal at the Navy-Marine Corps Court of Criminal Appeals, the United States Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces, and the United States Supreme Court.

In addition to my criminal litigation experience at the trial and appellate level, while in the Navy I also served as a White House Social Aide. In that position, I assisted the President and First Lady in their capacity as official host and hostess of the United States at formal social functions at the White House. Since I left active duty in August 2010, I have served as a reservist in the United States Navy.




I have been a member of the San Francisco chapter of VFP since March 2012 and host a weekly radio program dedicated to the concept of peace. I believe that peace can be achieved and one of the most effective ways of influencing the behavior of others is to set a good example. Be the change we wish to see and others will follow suit.

When I first arrived on the scene I expected to find a group of forward thinking veterans who are working together to make San Francisco and the world a better place, but instead found myself embroiled in an unnecessary war over the control of resources available at the SF Veterans Building (money, free office space & people), with VFP leading the charge. While the monthly VFP meetings condemn the tactics the government utilizes to achieve their ends, they themselves are riddled with deception, hidden agendas and conflicts of interests, justifying their means with righteousness and self-adoring entitlement while inflicting psychological violence on fellow Veterans.

Where there once was a community of thousands of veterans, there is now only a few dozen at best and the ongoing hostilities and dysfunctional attitudes keep veterans away. From my perspective, this chapter of VFP is indirectly responsible for dozens, if not hundreds of veteran suicides and attempts, because of the lack of positive community. Inside the War Memorial Veterans Building I have opened a museum dedicated to the concept of peace, not with the help of VFP, but in spite of its lack thereof. In summary....

There are 3 P's for some in Veterans For Peace,
and ironically Peace isn't anywhere to hear or see.
The 38,000 ft. of the WMVB is their golden fleece,
a fight lasting forever is one they fight with glee.

The first P is for Protest and to thirst for it flagrantly,
for every protest there is a themed marching parade,
and an after-party to celebrate their perceived victory,
the fights must go on with each one custom made.

The second P is for Parties at which they crave conformity,
spending on them to attend a regular basis is a must.
Standing up to take the honorary bow as if deservedly.
a celebration for themselves and the few they trust.

The third and last P of VFP stands for the marching Parade,
pretending to be the war heroes they wish they could never be,
remembering feeling great during the short boot-camp charade,
and hate the fact that it felt so good being active in the military.

I received a call today from Linda inviting me to attend the 1pm board meeting for the committee next week at City Hall. Unfortunately, I have a prior business commitment that I need to attend. Should circumstances change, I will certainly let you know.

I am sorry to miss the opportunity to meet the board, and ask you to please consider my application for membership.

As you can see from my application, I am a San Francisco resident and proud second generation veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps (my father served 1959-69, including Vietnam service 1967-68). My service took me in the United States from Virginia to Oklahoma and on to California, and overseas on deployments to Asia in 1997-98 and, after recall to active duty service, to Kuwait and Iraq in 2003.

Service to our country is among my proudest accomplishments in life, and I feel privileged to have had the opportunity to serve with the people I did. Several of my friends and former colleagues are still in uniform, and I know of the sacrifices our service members make to protect our national security. These sacrifices involve the commitment and dedication of individuals as well as their whole families, and of course can extend to bodily sacrifice and far too often to the loss of life. Even when combat veterans come back physically unhurt, they are often deeply scarred by their experiences and in need of guidance and support of entire communities to heal and re-integrate into society and productive lives. Far too often – even when there are people around them willing to help – they do not seek out or receive the proper care and assistance they need.

Board Qualifications:

The Veterans Affairs Commission consists of a total of seventeen members, twelve of whom are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and five of whom are appointed by the Mayor as follows: Of the seventeen members, at least three must be women veterans (at least 2 members shall be appointed by the Board) and two members who served in the Armed Forces of the United States and who have a physical disability arising from that service (the Mayor and Board of Supervisors shall each appoint at least one member), in accordance with the definitions applied in such cases by the Veterans' Administration. All members shall reside in the City and County of San Francisco. The Board of Supervisors may only waive this requirement by ordinance.

The term of each member of the Commission shall be four years, provided, however, that the members first appointed shall, by lot, classify their terms so that three members shall serve a one-year term, four members shall serve a two-year term, four members shall serve a three-year term and four members shall serve a four-year term. On the expiration of these and successive terms, their successors shall be appointed for a four-year term in a manner similar to that described for the initial members. In the event a vacancy occurs during the term of office of any member, a successor shall be appointed for the unexpired portion of the term of the office vacated in a manner similar to that described for the initial members.

The Commission shall advise directly the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors on all matters affecting veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States of American, on the problems,
