11 WHEREAS, Ocean Beach is an important tourist destination for people throughout the  
12 Bay Area, California and visitors the United States; and,

13 WHEREAS, Ocean Beach is home to various native plants and animals including  
14 protected species of the Bay Area whose survival depends upon a healthy ecosystem; and,

15 WHEREAS, Mayor Willie L. Brown, Jr. appointed the Ocean Beach Task Force in  
16 January 2000 to address and preserve the environmental well-being of Ocean Beach; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Ocean Beach Task Force has been working over the past three years  
18 to identify challenges and present solutions for erosion, natural resource, recreation and  
19 aesthetic issues at Ocean Beach; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the Ocean Beach Task Force  
21 for their commitment and service to the preservation of Ocean Beach as a natural, cultural  
22 and recreational resource for the residents and visitors of the City and County of San  
23 Francisco; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors encourages the Ocean Beach  
25 Task Force to continue in their role to protect and safeguard Ocean Beach.
