AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A SECOND AMENDMENT TO OPERATING AND LICENSING AGREEMENT FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO AFFINITY PHONE CARD PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, On May 20, 1996, the Board of supervisors approved an Operating and Licensing Agreement, by and between the City and Winston Taylor, Inc. ("Operator") regarding the sale of Official San Francisco Phone Cards, as amended by that certain First Amendment to Operating and licensing Agreement, dated June 2, 1997 (as amended, the "Agreement"); and,

WHEREAS, Under the Agreement, among other things, the City receives 20% of the revenue generated from the re-charging or re-use of S.F. Phone Cards ("Recharge Revenue"); and,

WHEREAS, That City and Operator have determined that in order to generate greater Recharge Revenue from the San Francisco Affinity Phone Card Program it will be necessary to reduce the rate charged by Operator on post-paid calling cards; and.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Second Amendment to Operating and Licensing Agreement, in substantially the form of the Second amendment filed herewith with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 990747 (the "Second Amendment"), the rate for post-paid calling cards will not exceed 19 cents a minute without the prior approval of the City, and City's royalty percentage of Recharge Revenues from such post-paid calling cards is reduced from 20% to 10-14%; and,

WHEREAS, The Second Amendment also clarifies certain expiration dates regarding the Operator's and the City's rights to mutually extend the term of the Agreement; and.

WHEREAS, The Second Amendment requires the Operator to fund a cooperative marketing fund to be administered by the City, the Operator and the San Francisco Visitors and Convention Bureau of up to 5% of gross revenues

WHEREAS, By entering into the Second Amendment, the City hopes to realize the opportunity to increase the total revenues paid to City pursuant to the San Francisco Affinity Phone Card Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board hereby approves the Second Amendment and authorizes the City Administrator to enter into the Second Amendment, in substantially the form attached hereto and in a form approved by the City Attorney.
