5 WHEREAS, Civic Day is the celebration of the 150th anniversary of the San Francisco
6 Chamber of Commerce; and,

7 WHEREAS, On April 19, 2000, the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce will present
8 Civic Day at City Hall with the presentation of a millennium time capsule; and,

9 WHEREAS, Civic Day also will serve as the opening of a three-month-long exhibit on
10 the history of San Francisco to be displayed at City Hall, the MH de Young Memorial
11 Museum, and the Museum of the City of San Francisco; and,

12 WHEREAS, Civic Day will include a tabletop forum in the North Light Court of City Hall
13 featuring some of San Francisco's oldest businesses, non-profit agencies, museums, and
14 local neighborhood associations and will also include San Francisco theme music,
15 entertainment, and food from local restaurants; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
17 declares April 19, 2000 "Civic Day" in the City and County of San Francisco.


