4	adopted by the Commission in whole or in part, the proposed amendment shall be presented
5	to the Board of Supervisors, which may approve or reject the amendment by a majority vote.

- E. On February 2, 2006, the Planning Commission initiated amendments to the South Bayshore Area Plan, an Area Plan of the San Francisco General Plan, at a duly noticed public hearing.
- F. On March 2, 2006, at a joint hearing with the Redevelopment Commission, the Planning Commission certified the Final EIR for the proposed Bayview Hunters Point Redevelopment Projects and Zoning proposal (the "Project") by Motion No. 17200 finding the Final EIR reflected the independent judgment and analysis of the City and County of San Francisco, is adequate, accurate and objective, contains no significant revisions to the Draft EIR, and the content of the report and the procedures through which the Final EIR was prepared, publicized and reviewed comply with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") (California Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.), the CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. Section 15000 et seq.) and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code. A copy of the Final EIR is on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No.

G. The Project evaluated in the Final EIR includes amendments to redevelopment plans proposed by the Redevelopment Agency and amendments to the General Plan and zoning in the Bayview Hunters Point area proposed by the Planning Department. The Updated South Bayshore Area Plan is an action proposed by the Planning Department to revise outdated information and to incorporate physical, social, and economic changes that

- have occurred in the area over the past ten years, and is within the scope of the Project
  evaluated in the Final EIR.

- J. The Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the Final EIR and the environmental documents on file referred to herein. The Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the CEQA Findings adopted by the Planning Commission in support of the approval of the Updated South Bayshore Area Plan, including the mitigation monitoring and reporting program and the statement of overriding considerations, and hereby adopts as its own and incorporates the CEQA Findings contained in Planning Commission Motion 17201 by reference as though such findings were fully set forth in this Ordinance.
- K. The Board of Supervisors endorses the implementation of the mitigation measures identified in the Planning Commission's CEQA Findings for implementation by other City Departments and recommends for adoption those mitigation measures that are enforceable by agencies other than City agencies, all as set forth in the CEQA Findings, including the mitigation monitoring and reporting program contained in the referenced CEQA Findings.
- L. The Board of Supervisors finds that no substantial changes have occurred in the Project proposed for approval under this Ordinance that will require revisions in the Final EIR due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects, no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the Project proposed for approval under the Ordinance are undertaken which will require major revisions to the Final EIR due to the
