4	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to		
5	accept and expend retroactively a new three year grant in the amount of \$160,000 for		
6	the first year from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to identify and		
7	develop integrated and innovative uses of surveillance data for sexually transmitted		
8	diseases and to enter into an agreement for the use of these funds; for the period of		
9	September 30, 2002 to September 29, 2003.

11	WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from CDC in the		
12	amount of \$160,000 to identify and develop integrated and innovative uses of surveillance		
13	data for sexually transmitted diseases; and,		
14	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDC requires the City to enter		
15	into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
16	Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this		
17	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
18	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$21,392; now,		
19	therefore, be it		
20	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a		
21	grant in the amount of \$160,000 from CDC; and, be it		
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the		
23	grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San		
24	Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
2	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
4	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
5	the agreement expires.
