WHEREAS, the website has already received over a million hits and substantial national media attention; and, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby commends

StopDrLaura.Com and the hardworking web activists who created it and maintain it; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges
Paramount Studios, KPIX and any local or national media company considering adding
Dr. Laura's show to their programming not do so until explicit, concrete and specific
assurances have been made by Dr. Laura that fair and accurate representations of Gay and
Lesbian citizens, as well as all citizens, will be a matter of policy.
