[Grant funding for a drug court in the San Francisco Dependency Court.]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to retroactively accept and expend a grant increase in the amount of \$287,177, with a local general fund match of \$28,718, for a budget total of \$315,895, from the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs' (DADP) Comprehensive Drug Court Implementation (CDCI) to provide funding for a drug court in the San Francisco Dependency Court; for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant increase from DADP in the amount of \$287,177, with a local general fund match of \$28,718, for a budget total of \$315,895, for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, for a grant originally awarded in FY 2006-07 to create a new drug court program, the Dependency Drug Court (DDC); and,

WHEREAS, Retroactive approval to July 1, 2007 is being sought due to delays in processing the agreement and so that FY 2007-08 and FY 2006-07 funds can be expended simultaneously; and,

WHEREAS, This is a joint project of the Superior Court, the Child Welfare Services of the San Francisco Human Services Agency and DPH, but is required by the funder to be administered through San Francisco County's Alcohol and Drug Programs Administrator, whose office is located at DPH; and,

WHEREAS, The budget of this grant is entirely Professional Service Contracts that were awarded on the basis of recent RFPs for Family and Perinatal Substance Abuse Treatment and also includes a sole source contract with the Superior Court for a Dependency Drug Court Coordinator; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, California DADP requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Notice of Grant Award"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 080044; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment because staffing is exclusively through the sub-contractors; and,

WHEREAS, The Department does not include indirect costs in the grant budget in order to maximize the use of grant funds on direct services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$287,177 from DADP; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget, and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Notice of Grant Award, pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.170-1.
