2 COMMENDING THE MENTAL HEALTH REHABILITATION FACILITY ON THE
3 OCCASION OF ITS RECEIVING THE THIRD PLACE 1999 LILLY SCHIZOPHRENIA
4 REINTEGRATION AWARD IN THE NURSING CATEGORY ALONG WITH A \$1500 GRANT

5 **WHEREAS**, On October 30, 1999, in New Orleans, San Francisco's Mental Health
6 Rehabilitation Facility received the Third-Place 1999 Lilly Schizophrenia Reintegration Award, in
7 the category of Nursing, for its efforts in providing long-term psychiatric rehabilitation to San
8 Francisco residents with chronic mental illnesses; and,

9 **WHEREAS**, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility located at San Francisco General
10 Hospital consists of approximately 200 staff members and is part of the Department of Public
11 Health's integrated delivery system; and,

12 **WHEREAS**, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility is a 24-hour, 7-days-a-week, 147-
13 bed facility that opened on November 6, 1996 and is led by Dr. Mozettia Henley; and,

14 **WHEREAS**, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility provides diagnostic evaluation and
15 treatment services for residents with severe and persistent mental illness; and,

16 **WHEREAS**, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility promotes independence and
17 enables residents to achieve their highest level of functioning; and,

18 **WHEREAS**, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility has reintegrated more than half of
19 its 334 patients (189 patients) into lower levels of community-based care since it opened its doors in
20 November of 1996; now, therefore be it

21 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
22 commends the Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility on the occasion of its receiving the Third-Place
23 1999 Schizophrenia Reintegration Award in the Nursing Category along with a \$1500 grant.




