WHEREAS, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility located at San Francisco General Hospital consists of approximately 200 staff members and is part of the Department of Public Health's integrated delivery system; and,

WHEREAS, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility is a 24-hour, 7-days-a-week, 147bed facility that opened on November 6, 1996 and is led by Dr. Mozettia Henley; and,

WHEREAS, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility provides diagnostic evaluation and treatment services for residents with severe and persistent mental illness; and,

WHEREAS, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility promotes independence and enables residents to achieve their highest level of functioning; and,

WHEREAS, The Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility has reintegrated more than half of its 334 patients (189 patients) into lower levels of community-based care since it opened its doors in November of 1996; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends the Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility on the occasion of its receiving the Third-Place 1999 Schizophrenia Reintegration Award in the Nursing Category along with a \$1500 grant.
