RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE HEALTH SERVICES SYSTEM BOARD FOR INCLUDING TRANSSEXUAL CARE AND TREATMENT IN SAN FRANCISCO HEALTH PLANS

WHEREAS, voters added gender identity as a protected class in 1993 to the City's Civil Service Code; and

WHEREAS, the Human Rights Commission conducted a public hearing in May 1994 investigating discrimination against the transgender community; and

WHEREAS, a Commission finding from the public hearing is that transgender people have great difficulty obtaining medical and social services from both government and private agencies; and

WHEREAS, a Commission finding from the public hearing is that insurance companies discriminate against transgender individuals by excluding them from coverage for necessary treatments and procedures and for complications or conditions that may arise from these treatments and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco added gender identity as a protected class in December 1994 in its Administrative Code (Chapter 12) and Municipal Code (Article 33); and

WHEREAS, transgender City employees require basic health care related to their status and cannot obtain these services through their City-provided health plans, thus not having equal access to necessary health care under these plans;

WHEREAS, all health insurance plans available to City employees presently discriminate against transgender employees by denying supervisors

coverage for treatments and surgeries that are available to City employees who are not transgender, and by denying treatments and surgeries that may be medically necessary for transgender City employees; and,

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Health Service System Board will be voted to include transsexual surgeries and treatment in the city health plans on February 2^{nd} 2001, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors calls on the Health Service System Board to eliminate the exclusions for transsexual surgeries and treatment in City health plans; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors commends the Health Service System Board for its inclusion of transsexual treatments and surgeries in City health plans beginning with the coming fiscal year.
