authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and expend
continued funding for this project from OCJP, and waiving indirect costs due to funding
constraints; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San
Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the
necessary Grant Award Agreement for this project including any extensions, funding
augmentations from OCJP, or amendments thereof; and be it
