

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - California Victim Compensation Board - Compensation for
2 Crime Victims - \$2,530,992]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and expend a**
4 **grant in the amount of \$2,530,992 from the California Victim Compensation Board for**
5 **a project, entitled “Joint Powers Agreement S24-012,” to assist victims and**
6 **witnesses with compensation claims for the period July 1, 2024, through**
7 **June 30, 2027.**

9 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, Office of the District Attorney
10 (“District Attorney”) desires to enter into an agreement with the California Victim
11 Compensation Board in accordance with Government Code, Section 13952.5, for the purpose
12 of assisting victims and witnesses with compensation claims; and

13 WHEREAS, The District Attorney currently has an agreement in place with the
14 California Victim Compensation Board to provide these services to victims and witnesses, and
15 the new grant agreement would be a continuation of that program; and

16 WHEREAS, Funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that
17 would, in the absence of California Victim Compensation Board Programs, be made available
18 to support the assistance of victims and witnesses of crime; and

19 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded “G” in the District
20 Attorney’s budget; and

21 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance
22 (ASO); and

23 WHEREAS, The grant budget does not include provision for indirect costs; now,
24 therefore, be it
