

1 [Grant to support the Hospital Preparedness Program through the San Francisco Department
2 of Public Health.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH), to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$565,230.32 from the**
5 **California Department of Health Services, Emergency Preparedness Office, for year 4 of**
6 **the Hospital Preparedness Program, for the period of September 1, 2005, through**
7 **August 31, 2006.**

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9 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant in the amount of
10 \$565,230.32 from the California Department of Health Services, Emergency Preparedness
11 Office, with funding from the federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA),
12 for year 4 of the Hospital Preparedness Program for the period of September 1, 2005, through
13 August 31, 2006; and,

14 WHEREAS, The original budget period was September 1, 2005 through August 31,
15 2006 and 12 months extension is pending, with a possible new closing date of August 31,
16 2007; and,

17 WHEREAS, These grants allow counties to upgrade local hospitals, clinics and
18 emergency medical services systems preparedness for a response to bioterrorism, other
19 outbreaks of infectious disease and other public health threats and emergencies; and,

20 WHEREAS, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize SFDPH to accept
21 and expend retroactively \$565,230.32 for year 4 of the Hospital Preparedness Program for the
22 period of September 1, 2005, through August 31, 2006, set forth in Board of Supervisors' file
23 number _____ and incorporated herein by reference, between the governing
24 body of the City and County of San Francisco and the State Department of Health Services
25 Emergency Preparedness Office; and,

1 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$60,682.22, now
2 therefore be it

3 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a
4 grant in the amount of \$564,230.32 from the California Department of Health Services,
5 Emergency Preparedness Office; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
7 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement,
8 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
10 agreement on behalf of the City.
