5 WHEREAS, As public assistance recipients begin to enter the labor market, many will  
6 initially be employed at low wage jobs due to a lack of work experience; and,

7 WHEREAS, These individuals and other low income workers will require all the  
8 supports possible to attain self-sufficiency; and,

9 WHEREAS, A State Earned Income Tax Credit would provide these workers with  
10 additional income to assist them as they progress toward self-sufficiency; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
12 urges the California State Legislature to establish a State Earned Income Tax Credit ; and, be  
13 it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the  
15 Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the  
16 State Legislature, as well as Governor-elect Gray Davis, with a request they all take action  
17 necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
