WHEREAS, Sensei Keiko Fukuda was honored as the National Living Treasure of Japan by the Emperor of Japan in 1990; and

WHEREAS, In 1973 Sensei Keiko Fukuda opened her studio, Soko Joshi Judo Club, located at 26th Street and Castro Street were she inspires her students with her motto "Be strong, be gentle, be beautiful"; and

WHEREAS, Sensei Keiko Fukuda has become a revered role model and an inspiration especially within the Women's community, for her dedication to her art as well as her devotion

to her students many of whom travel significant distances to attend classes at her studio; now, therefore be it
