


PROJECT SITE

Context

2017 AB 857 legislates low-cost leases for open-space use of freeway lots Central SOMA Plan of 2018 calls for additional open-space in this neighborhood

Site

Caltrans property from 4th to 6th streets, from Harrison to Bryant Streets

Funds \$626,000

Study Goals increase safety of pedestrian and bicycle routes

provide new neighborhood open-space

reduce flooding

mitigate air pollution

decrease urban heat island
