RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Examiner, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City and County of San Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic news and intelligence of a general character, having a bona fide circulation of at least 50,000 copies per calendar week, printed in the City and County on three or more days in a calendar week, is hereby designated as an official newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco, commencing July 1, 1999, for the publication of all official advertising of the City and County which is required by law to be published on two or more consecutive days, and all official advertising of the City and County which is required to be published in accordance with the provisions of §2.103 of the Charter for special meetings of the Board of Supervisors and its standing or special committees.
