3 **Resolution reaffirming approval of the CleanPowerSF Updated 2015 Implementation**
4 **Plan and Statement of Intent for community choice aggregation program, including**
5 **modifications consistent with the 2015 Implementation Plan.**

7 WHEREAS, In 2004, the Board of Supervisors unanimously established a Community
8 Choice Aggregation (CCA) program (Ord. No. 86-04), now called CleanPowerSF in
9 accordance with California Public Utilities Code Sections 218.3, 331.1, 366, 366.2, 381.1,
10 394, and 394.25, allowing San Francisco to aggregate the electrical load of consumers within
11 San Francisco and to accelerate the use of renewable energy, conservation and energy
12 efficiency in San Francisco; and

13 WHEREAS, In 2007, the Board of Supervisors adopted a CCA Program Description,
14 Revenue Bond Action Plan, and Draft Implementation Plan (Ord. No. 147-07); and

15 WHEREAS, In 2009, the Board of Supervisors found further approvals necessary to
16 effectuate Ordinances 86-04, 146-07, 147-07, and 232-09 and could be made by Resolution
17 to the extent otherwise permitted by law (Ord. No. 232-09); and

18 WHEREAS, In 2010 the Board of Supervisors adopted a Draft Implementation Plan
19 and authorized the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (PUC)
20 to file with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) an implementation plan
21 consistent with that ordinance (Ord. No. 45-10); and

22 WHEREAS, The PUC submitted previous versions of the implementation plan to CPUC
23 on March 3, 2010, and November 12, 2012; and

24 WHEREAS, CPUC approved these previous versions of the implementation plan on
25 May 18, 2010, and June 7, 2012; and

1 WHEREAS, The PUC has recently made changes to CleanPowerSF resulting in the
2 need to update the 2012 Implementation Plan; and

3 WHEREAS On July 14, 2015, the PUC approved the Updated 2015 Implementation
4 Plan and Statement of Intent (PUC Res. No. _____); now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors reaffirms its approval of the CleanPowerSF
6 Implementation Plan, including changes consistent with the Updated 2015 Implementation
7 Plan.

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
