1 [Approve retroactively a new position funded by a recurring State grant for the period of FY  
2 2005 through FY 2007.]

3 **Resolution authorizing retroactively the San Francisco Department of Public Health**  
4 **(SFDPH), San Francisco Childhood Lead Prevention Program to fill a new position**  
5 **using existing and ongoing funds from a recurring State grant, for the period of July 1,**  
6 **2005 through June 30, 2007.**

8 WHEREAS, Resolution #705-05 authorized the SFDPH to accept and expend recurring  
9 State grant funds in the total amount of \$29,596,579 for Fiscal Year 2005 through Fiscal Year  
10 2006; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Lead Case Management grant in the amount of \$79,955 is included  
12 on page 1, Schedule A, of the above cited document; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Lead Case Management grant will be included in the FY 2006-2007  
14 State recurring grant resolution; and,

15 WHEREAS, all new positions require approval by the Board of Supervisors; and,

16 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Childhood Lead Prevention Program requests  
17 retroactive approval by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors for a new position to be  
18 funded by the State Lead Case Management grant for FY 2005-2006 and FY 2006-2007; and,

19 WHEREAS, the State Department of Lead Case Management has approved the hiring  
20 of a new position in the San Francisco Childhood Lead Prevention Program for FY 2005-2006  
21 and FY 2006-2007 in the total cost of \$66,011.40; and

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs totaling \$7,072.65;  
23 now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively authorizes the SFDPH  
2 to include the new position in the Lead Case Management grant budgets of FY 2005-2006  
3 and FY 2006-2007; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position  
5 created as a "G" or grant-funded position, which would terminate when the grant expires.
