WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco and the District Attorney desire to enter into an agreement with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims

Board in accordance with Government Section 13835 for the purpose of verification of victim compensation claims; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors on August 14, 2007, approved Resolution No. 467-07, File No. 071084; which Resolution now requires a change in the therein approved amount of contract funds to be accepted and expended, from \$1,184,530 to \$1,356,678, to correct an inadvertent error;

WHEREAS, Grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that would, in the absence of California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board Programs, be made available to support the assistance of victims and witnesses of crime; and WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

1	WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded "G" in the District	
2	Attorney's budget; and	
3	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$14,696; and	
4	WHEREAS, The District Attorney and the City and County of San Francisco desire to	
5	renew the current contract with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims	
6	Board to provide a means to pay for verified funeral/burial expenses and emergency	
7	relocation for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault, and be reimbursed by the State	
8	thereafter, and	
9	WHEREAS, This contract would authorize the District Attorney's Victim Witness	
10	Assistance Program to pay verified funeral/burial expenses and emergency relocation for	
11	victims of domestic violence and sexual assault out of the revolving funeral/burial fund; and	
12	WHEREAS, The fund maintains a process by which the District Attorney may make	
13	speedy payments to service providers and increase services to victims; and,	
14	WHEREAS, The California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board has	
15	simplified its procedures by combining the previously separate contracts for the Victim	
16	Witness Assistance Program and the Revolving Loan Fund into one Joint Power and	
17	Revolving Fund Contract, now, therefore, be it	
18	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of	
19	the City and County of San Francisco to execute on behalf of the City and County of San	
20	Francisco a Joint Power and Revolving Fund Contract with the California Victim	
21	Compensation and Government Claims Board, including any extensions, augmentations or	
22	amendments thereof, which shall include provisions to (i) contract for, accept and expend up	
23	to \$1,356,678 from the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board for the	
24	assistance of victims and witnesses of crime for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30,	
25	2009; and (ii) renew the revolving loan fund to be used to pay for verified funeral/burial	

1	expenses and emergency relocation for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault,		
2	extending it for an additional two years, from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009; and be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to sign and submit		
4	claims to the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board for		
5	reimbursement of funds expended for verified funeral/burial expenses and emergency		
6	relocation for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault; and be it		
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the State fund received hereunder shall not be used to		
8	supplant local funds that would in the absence of the agreement, be made available to		
9	support assistance to victims of crime.
