WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has applied for and been awarded a grant from The California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs in the amount of \$367,942 for the Drug Court Partnership Program to provide viable alternatives to incarceration and addressing prison and jail overcrowding; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, The California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_000145\_; and

WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it
