

1 [Supporting a fiscal feasibility study of the SFPUC’s proposed “Combustion Turbine Peaker
2 Project “]

3 **Resolution supporting a fiscal feasibility study of the SFPUC’s proposed “Combustion**
4 **Turbine Peaker Project” as required under Section 29.1 c4 of the Administrative Code.**
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6 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is facing a \$328 million dollar
7 budget deficit; and,

8 WHEREAS, Due to the budget deficit, the City and County of San Francisco is facing
9 layoffs and is slashing essential services; and,

10 WHEREAS, The State of California is facing an \$11 billion dollar deficit; and,

11 WHEREAS, Due to the budget deficit, the State of California is laying off teachers and
12 slashing essential services; and,

13 WHEREAS, Given the current budget climate at the City and State level it may not be
14 fiscally responsible to spend over \$250 million of state and local funds on a fossil fuel power
15 plant; and,

16 WHEREAS, City law requires a fiscal feasibility study of new construction projects over
17 \$25 million dollars; and,

18 WHEREAS, It is in the City’s interest to conduct an independent study of the fiscal
19 impacts and feasibility of the “Combustion Turbine Peaker Project; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco demands that Chapter 29 of
21 the Administrative Code be followed for the “Combustion Turbine Peakers Project”; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a fiscal feasibility study of the proposed “Combustion
23 Turbine Peakers Project” be conducted by the Budget Analyst and Controller in conjunction
24 with the Department of the Environment, whether or not it is required by Administrative Code
25 Chapter 29 and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will halt all work on
2 this project, including entering into a contract to build the “Peakers”, until the fiscal feasibility
3 study is complete.

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
