AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO APPLY FOR RETROACTIVELY, ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE "CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS BOATING SAFETY AND ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT GRANT" FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO POLICE DEPARTMENT'S MARINE UNIT.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco desires to participate in a program designated "Boating Safety and Enforcement Equipment Grant" funded from funds made available through the California Department of Boating and Waterways to provide financial aid for law enforcement agencies having a boating and safety unit; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Boating and Waterways has offered the San Francisco Police Department a grant to be used exclusively for it's Marine Unit; and

WHEREAS, benefits provided through this State Program will enable the Police Department to more effectively enforce laws and promote boating safety; now therefore be it

RESOLVED; that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to apply for retroactively, accept and expend funding for this program from the California Department of Boating and Waterways, and waiving indirect costs due to funding constraints; and be it

The State of California and the Department of Boating and Waterways disclaim responsibility for and such liability; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.


