

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - California Governor's Office of Emergency
2 Services - Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims Program- \$163,145]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$163,145 from the California Governor's Office of**
5 **Emergency Services for the Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims Program**
6 **for the grant period January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020.**

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8 WHEREAS, California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) awarded
9 \$163,145 to the Office of the District Attorney for the Innovative Response to Marginalized
10 Victims (KI) Program; and

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to support innovative projects that serve
12 marginalized victims of crime; and

13 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary
14 Ordinance (ASO) Amendment; and

15 WHEREAS, The grant includes a required match of 20% of the project budget or
16 \$40,786; the source of matching funds is the District Attorney's Office general fund; and

17 WHEREAS, The grant includes provision for indirect costs of \$16,585; now,
18 therefore, be it

19 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the District
20 Attorney to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San
21 Francisco, a grant from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the
22 Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims Program in the amount of \$163,145.
