WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic wishes to re-bid its existing contract for janitorial services at the Parking Authority's twenty one off-street, metered parking lots and five Department of Parking and Traffic facilities; and,

WHEREAS, The Controller certified on December 7, 2001 that said services can be performed at lower cost to the City and County by a contractor than by employees of the City and County; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's certification and authorizes the Department of Parking and Traffic to contract for janitorial services for FY 2001-2002.
