

1 [Suspending Board Rule 4.38 to Permit the Board of Supervisors to Consider an Amendment  
2 to Rule 5.7 Extending the Joint City and School District Committee for One Year Ending  
3 March 1, 2012]

4 **Motion suspending Rule 4.38 of the Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order to consider,**  
5 **without reference, an amendment to Rule 5.7 to extend the term of the Joint City and**  
6 **School District Select Committee for one year ending March 1, 2012.**

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8 WHEREAS, Rule 4.38 of the Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order requires that all  
9 proposed amendments to the Rules of Order shall be referred to the Rules Committee for  
10 public hearing and recommendation; and

11 WHEREAS, Rule 4.37 allows Rule 4.38 to be suspended by the affirmative vote of  
12 eight Board Members, unless there are less than eight Board Members present, in which case  
13 the unanimous consent of the Board Members present, but not less than six Board Members,  
14 shall be required; and

15 WHEREAS, Due to the current term of the Joint City and School District Select  
16 Committee, pursuant to Rule 5.7 of the Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order, expires on  
17 March 1, 2011, the Board Members wish to suspend the operation of Rule 4.38 with regard to  
18 the consideration of the proposed amendment to Rule 5.7, now, therefore, be it

19 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, as  
20 allowed by Rule 4.37 of its Rules of Order, hereby suspends the operation of Rule 4.38 of the  
21 Board's Rules of Order with regard to the Board's consideration of the proposed amendment  
22 to Rule 5.7; and, be it

23 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby amends Rule 5.7 of the  
24 Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order, to read as follows:

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1           **5.7 Joint City and School District Select Committee.** The Joint City and School  
2 District Select Committee shall be referred measures concerning issues of mutual interest that  
3 affect the City and the School District, its employees, its students, and the families of its  
4 students, including the issue of the public use of School District facilities, and shall terminate  
5 on, or before, March 1, 2012.

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
