Section 2. Special price lists referenced in Section 128 of the Health Code are available on request at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving of it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor’s veto of the ordinance. As stated in Section 128 of the Health Code, the rates specified therein shall apply starting July 1, 2015.

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the municipal code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment

1 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
2 the official title of the ordinance.
