18           Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after

19 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

20 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board

21 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor’s veto of the ordinance.

23           Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors

24 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,

25 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal

1 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment  
2 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the “Note” that appears under  
3 the official title of the ordinance.

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**LEGISLATIVE DIGEST**

*(Amended 3/13/2023)*

[Administrative Code - Health Service System Eligibility for Members of New Commission]

**Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to provide that members of the Homelessness Oversight Commission are eligible for health insurance coverage through the San Francisco Health Service System.**

Existing Law

Section 16.700 of Chapter 16 of the Administrative Code currently authorizes members of certain City boards and commissions to be eligible to participate in the Health Service System.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would add the Homelessness Oversight Commission to the authorized list of City boards and commissions, members of whom would be eligible to participate in the Health Service System. The proposed ordinance would also make conforming changes to the names of boards and commissions that were already on the list.

Background

This legislative digest reflects amendments made in the Rules Committee on March 13, 2023. Those amendments removed reference to the Refuse Rate Board from the ordinance. As a result, the ordinance does not make members of the Refuse Rate Board eligible for health insurance coverage through the San Francisco Health Service System.
