

4 **Resolution Condemning the September 24, 2010, FBI raids on Trade Union, Anti-War,**
5 **and Solidarity Activists.**

7 WHEREAS, On the morning of September 24, 2010, in coordinated raids, FBI agents
8 entered eight homes and offices of trade union and anti-war activists in Minneapolis and
9 Chicago, confiscating computers, passports, books, cell phones, notebooks and personal
10 belongings. The FBI served subpoenas to at least thirteen activists to appear before a
11 Federal Grand Jury; and

12 WHEREAS, The majority of those targeted by the FBI raids had participated in anti-war
13 protests at the 2008 Republican National Convention in St. Paul MN, which resulted in
14 hundreds of beatings and arrests, with almost all charges subsequently dropped; and

15 WHEREAS, The nationally coordinated dawn raids and fishing expedition marks a new
16 and dangerous chapter in the protracted assault on the First Amendment rights of every union
17 fighter, solidarity activist or anti-war campaigner, which began with 9/11 and the USA Patriot
18 Act. There is now great concern that the FBI is using the pretext of investigating "terrorism" in
19 an attempt to intimidate activists; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors denounces the Sept. 24,
21 2010, FBI raids on the homes and offices of trade union, solidarity and anti-war activists in
22 Minneapolis, Chicago and elsewhere; the confiscation of computers and personal belongings;
23 and the issuance of Grand Jury subpoenas. The FBI raids are reminiscent of the Palmer
24 Raids, McCarthy hearings, J. Edgar Hoover, and COINTELPRO, and mark a new and

1 dangerous chapter in the protracted assault on the First Amendment rights of every union
2 fighter, international solidarity activist or anti-war campaigner.
