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3 **Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to extend by five months (to August 31,**
 4 **2020) the deadline for the Street-Level Drug Distribution Task Force to submit its initial**
 5 **report to the Board of Supervisors and Mayor, and to revise the contents of that report**
 6 **and subsequent reports issued every three months, to require a summary of the**
 7 **progress of the Task Force and its plans for the next three-month period.**

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13 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

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15 Section 1. Article XXII of Chapter 5 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by
 16 revising Section 5.22-4, to read as follows:

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18 **SEC. 5.22-4. POWERS AND DUTIES.**

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20 (b) Beginning ~~March~~August 31, 2020 and every three months thereafter, the Task
 21 Force shall submit to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor a report summarizing *data*
 22 *regarding harms related to street-level drug dealing in the Tenderloin, Civic Center, Mid-Market, and*
 23 *South of Market neighborhoods, and making recommendations regarding policies, funding levels and*
 24 *sources, enforcement strategies, and other pertinent matters, with the goal of addressing harms related*

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
