5	annual licensing fees for permits from the Fire Department such that all annual
6	licensing fees for permits from the Fire Department are set at \$240 per year, to become
7	operative on January 1, 2005.

11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
12	Section 1.
13	The Planning Department concluded environmental review of this ordinance pursuant
14	to the California Environmental Quality Act. Documentation of that review is on file with the
15	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No
16	Section 2. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
17	by amending Section 90, to read as follows:
18	SEC. 90. GARAGES.
19	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of operating or maintaining a
20	garage that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee for
21	such garage of \$240.00 per annum.as follows:
22	For a garage with a total floor area of ten thousand square feet or less, \$172 per annum.
23	For each additional five thousand square feet or part thereof, \$22 per annum.
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1	Section 3. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
2	by amending Section 93, to read as follows:
3	SEC. 93 SERVICE STATIONS
4	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, conducting
5	or operating a service station that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an
6	annual license fee of \$240172.
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8	Section 4. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
9	by amending Section 93.1, to read as follows:
10	SEC. 93.1. SELF-SERVICE STATIONS.
11	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, conducting
12	or operating a self-service station that requires a permit from the Fire Department, and jointly
13	administered by the Fire and Health Departments, shall pay an annual license fee of $$240242$.
14	
15	Section 5. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
16	by amending Section 94, to read as follows:
17	SEC. 94. AUTOMOBILE PARKING STATIONS.
18	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, conducting
19	or operating an automobile parking station that requires a permit from the Fire Department
20	shall pay an annual license fee as follows:
21	(a) Automobile Parking Lots shall pay a license fee of \$240172 per annum.
22	(b) Parking structures with a total floor area of ten thousand square feet or less shall
23	pay a license fee of \$240172 per annum.
24	(c) For each additional five thousand square feet or part thereof, per \$22 annum.
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1	Section 6. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
2	by amending Section 236, to read as follows:
3	SEC. 236. TIRE REBUILDING PLANTS.
4	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining and operating
5	a tire rebuilding plant that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual
6	license fee of \$240146.
7	
8	Section 7. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
9	by amending Section 237, to read as follows:
10	SEC. 237. PLACES OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLY AND OPEN-AIR ASSEMBLY.
11	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of maintaining, operating or
12	using a building or structure as a place of public assembly or open-air assembly that requires
13	a permit from the Fire Department, and where a license is not required elsewhere in the
14	Municipal Code, shall pay an annual license fee as follows:
15	(a) A public assembly unit with an occupant load of less than 100 persons shall pay an
16	annual license fee of \$240146.
17	A public assembly unit having an occupant load of 100 to 1,000 persons shall pay an annual fee
18	of \$146.
19	Each additional occupant load of 1,000 persons or part thereof, shall pay an additional annual
20	license fee of \$22.
21	(b) An open-air assembly, other than a stadium or a structure with stadium-type
22	seating, having an occupant load of 100 to 1,000 persons shall pay an annual license fee of
23	\$ <u>240</u> 146.
24	Each additional occupant load of 1,000 persons or part thereof, shall pay an annual license fee
25	of \$22.

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1	(c) An open-air assembly, stadium or structure with stadium-type seating, having an
2	occupant load of 100 to 5,000 persons shall pay an annual license fee of \$240146.
3	Each additional occupant load of 5,000 persons or part thereof, shall pay an additional annual
4	license fee of \$22.
5	
6	Section 8. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
7	by amending Section 238, to read as follows:
8	SEC. 238. NITROCELLULOSE FILM AND PLASTICS.
9	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of processing, storing or
10	using nitrocellulose motion picture film that requires a permit from the Fire Department; or, the
11	processing and storage of nitrocellulose plastics that requires a permit from the Fire
12	Department, shall pay an annual license fee of \$240146.
13	
14	Section 9. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby amended
15	by amending Section 239, to read as follows:
16	SEC. 239. STORAGE OF CERTAIN COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS.
17	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in any business of storing combustible
18	fibers, waste materials, lumber or readily combustible materials that requires a permit from the
19	Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of \$240146.
20	
21	Section 10. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
22	amended by amending Section 240, to read as follows:
23	SEC. 240. STORAGE AND USE OF FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS.
24	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing, using or
25	transporting flammable liquids, including flammable liquid fuel oil, that requires a permit from

1	the Fire Department, unless such person shall have secured a license under Sections 90 or
2	93 of this Article, shall pay an annual license fee as follows:
3	(a) For a flammable liquid storage tank located underground, \$240133 per annum.
4	Each additional underground flammable liquid storage tank located at the same site, \$22 per
5	annum.
6	(b) For the first 100,000 gallons or part thereof, of flammable liquids stored above
7	ground in bulk storage plants, \$240172 per annum.
8	Each additional 100,000 gallons or part thereof, stored at the same site, \$22 per annum.
9	(c) For the first 100,000 gallons or part thereof, of flammable liquids stored above
10	ground in processing plants, \$240172 per annum.
11	Each additional 100,000 gallons or part thereof, stored at the site, \$22 per annum.
12	(d) For an aboveground flammable liquid storage tank, located at other than a bulk
13	storage plant or a processing plant, \$24090 per annum.
14	For each additional aboveground flammable liquid storage tank, located at the same site, \$22
15	per annum.
16	(d) For a portable tank (gas buggy), \$24090 per annum.
17	
18	Section 11. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
19	amended by amending Section 241, to read as follows:
20	SEC. 241. FUMIGATION AND FOGGING.
21	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of fumigating and fogging
22	that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of $$24090$.
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1	Section 12. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
2	amended by amending Section 242, to read as follows:
3	SEC. 242. STORAGE AND USE OF LIQUEFIED GASES AND COMPRESSED
4	GASES.
5	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing or using liquefied
6	petroleum gases or compressed gases that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall
7	pay an annual license fee of \$240129.
8	
9	Section 13. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
10	amended by amending Section 242.1, to read as follows:
11	SEC. 242.1. STORAGE AND USE OF LIQUEFIED GASES AND COMPRESSED
12	GASES (50 GALLONS OR LESS).
13	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing or using liquefied
14	petroleum gases or compressed gases in the aggregate of 50-gallon capacity or less, that
15	requires a permit from the Fire Department, shall pay an annual license fee of $$240129$.
16	
17	Section 14. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
18	amended by amending Section 243, to read as follows:
19	SEC. 243. ERECTION AND USE OF ACETYLENE GENERATORS; STORAGE OF
20	CALCIUM CARBIDE.
21	Every person, firm or corporation installs uses an acetylene generator for which a
22	permit is required for the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of $$240129$.
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1	Section 15. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
2	amended by amending Section 244, to read as follows:
3	SEC. 244. APPLICATION OF FLAMMABLE FINISHES; AND USE AND
4	OPERATION OF INDUSTRIAL BAKING AND DRYING OVENS.
5	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of applying flammable
6	finishes that requires a permit from the Fire Department; or using or operating an industrial
7	baking and drying oven that requires a permit from the Fire Department, shall pay an annual
8	license fee of \$240172.
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10	Section 16. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
11	amended by amending Section 245, to read as follows:
12	SEC. 245. PROCESSING OF CERTAIN HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.
13	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of processing magnesium or
14	titanium that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual license fee of
15	\$ <u>240</u> 146.
16	
17	Section 17. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
18	amended by amending Section 246, to read as follows:
19	SEC. 246. OPERATING A TANK VEHICLE.
20	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of transporting flammable
21	liquids by tank vehicle, and providing such tank vehicle requires a permit from the Fire
22	Department, shall pay an annual fee of \$240146 for each tank vehicle.
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1	Section 18. The San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code is hereby
2	amended by amending Section 247, to read as follows:
3	SEC. 247. HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS.
4	Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of storing and using a
5	hazardous chemical that requires a permit from the Fire Department shall pay an annual
6	license fee of \$240172.
7 8	Section 19. This ordinance shall become operative on January 1, 2005.
9	Section 20. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
10	this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
11	Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.) Said determination is on on file with the Clerk
12	of the Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by reference
