9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby  
11 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled William "Bill" Maier v. City and County  
12 of San Francisco, et al., Superior Court of the State of California, County of San Francisco,  
13 Case No. CGC-18-564070, by the payment of \$198,000. The lawsuit involves an employment  
14 dispute.

17 San Francisco, on February 2, 2018, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit:  
18 Plaintiff: William Maier; Defendants: City and County of San Francisco, Bridget O'Connor.



