8	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
9	Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending	Section	
10	33.5, to read as follows:		
11	Sec. 33.5 SPECIAL SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONES. When the Police Commission shall		
12	determine the establishment of special school loading zones on the streets in the City and Co	unty of San	
13 14	Francisco is reasonably necessary or desirable for the regulation of traffic or for the safety o	yf school	
15	children, it is hereby authorized to designate such zones wherein The Department of Parking	<u>g and</u>	
16	Traffic shall, upon written request from School Administration officials, designate a special s	school bus	
17	loading zone at or near all kindergarten through grade twelve school sites that utilize school	buses to	
18	transport school children, as reasonably necessary or desirable for the regulation of traffic o	<u>or safety of</u>	
19	school children. These zones shall prohibit the stopping, standing or parking of unauthor	<u>ized</u>	
20	vehicles in such special school bus loading zones between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:0)0 p.m. or	
21 22	any portion thereof as determined by the Police Commission as determined by the Direc	tor of the	
23	Department of Parking and Traffic on any day except Saturday and Sunday and any	day	
24	declared to be a school holiday by the Board of Education shall be limited to school buses owned

or operated by the San Francisco Unified School District or under contract with the San Francisco
Unified School District to transport school children.
No person shall stand, stop or park any vehicle, except those enumerated herein, whether
attended or unattended, on the days and between the hours designated by the Police Commission
except Saturday and Sunday and school holidays declared such by the Board of Education.
The term "school bus" as used in this Section shall mean any motor vehicle designed, used or maintained primarily for the transportation of school children and as defined in Section
545 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California.
Nothing in this Article shall be construed to prohibit motor vehicles from standing, stopping or parking within any zone heretofore or hereinafter provided for the loading or unloading of passengers subject to the provisions of Section 38.C of this Code.
The curbs of zones declared to be school loading zones <i>by the Police Commission</i> -shall be painted white in color and the words "SCHOOL BUS LOADING – TOW AWAY ZONE" shall be painted white in red upon the curb. <i>The school bus loading zone</i> will <u>shall</u> <i>have</i> <i>appropriate signage on either end of said zone</i> . Any person violating the provisions of this Section 33.5 shall be deemed guilty of an infraction and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$100.
