13 14	WHEREAS, CDCSS appointed San Francisco as the lead county in the thirty-four					
15	county Consortium; and,					
16	WHEREAS, the California Department of Child Support Services (CDCSS) directed					
17	seven other California counties to convert to CASES as an interim system of managing child					
18	support caseloads pending development of a statewide system; and,					
19	WHEREAS, The Family Support Bureau of the District Attorney's Office, after a					
20	competitive procurement process, selected Informatix, Inc a Local Business Enterprise (LBE)					
21 22	and a Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) registered with the Human Rights Commission, to					
23	provide the computer consulting services necessary to convert the seven counties to CASES					
24	and to maintain the system for the forty-one counties operating on CASES thereafter; and,					

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1	WHEREAS, CDCSS has directed the City Department of Child Support Services to						
2	enter into an extension of the City's existing contract with Informatix, Inc, for fiscal year						
3	2003-2004 to provide maintenance and operations for the CASES system for the thirty-four						
4	counties and to assist in the conversion of seven additional counties to the CASES system;

6	WHEREAS, The federal and state governments, through the CDCSS, provides all						
7	funding for the consulting services provided by Informatix, Inc.; and,						
8 9	WHEREAS, the additional terms set forth in the Fourth Amendment and Second						
10	Extension requires a modification to the amount of the original contract in the total sum of						
11	\$14, 005, 910 as stated in the Personal Services Contract Summary; and,						
12	WHEREAS, Pursuant to San Francisco Charter Section 9.118, the Agreement between						
13	Informatix, Inc. and City for approval, which Agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
