2 ASKING OUR LEGISLATIVE ANALYSTS TO RESEARCH CITY AND COUNTY FLEET
3 MANAGEMENT, INCLUDING PERFORMING AN AUDIT OF THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES
4 AND THE PROCESS BY WHICH THOSE VEHICLES ARE SHARED AND ANALYZING BEST
5 PRACTICES FROM OTHER CITIES; AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO REDUCE THE
6 NUMBER OF CITY VEHICLES ON THE STREETS OF SAN FRANCISCO.

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco is committed to promoting a sustainable community through healthy
8 environmental practices and a transit first policy; and,

9 WHEREAS, Each City Department has access to a certain number of non-centrally managed
10 vehicles; and,

11 WHEREAS, San Francisco has the highest number of vehicles per square mile of any United
12 States City; and,

13 WHEREAS, San Francisco has gone on record in support of car-sharing activities which allow
14 more than one person to use the same vehicle in the hope that such use will reduce the overall vehicle
15 ownership; now, therefore, be it

16 MOVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby ask our Legislative
17 Analysts to research the City and County fleet management, including performing an audit of the
18 number of vehicles and the process by which those vehicles are shared and analyzing best practices
19 from other cities; and to make recommendations to reduce the number of City vehicles on the streets of
20 San Francisco .


