[Administrative Code - Employee Donations to San Francisco Firefighter and EMS Behavioral Health Foundation]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to add the San Francisco Firefighter and EMS Behavioral Health Foundation to the list of organizations to which City officers and employees may make donations by payroll deduction.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Chapter 16, Article V of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 16.93, to read as follows:

SEC. 16.93. ORGANIZATIONS FOR WHICH DEDUCTIONS CAN BE MADE.

Deductions and collections as provided by this Article V shall be made for the organizations and the purposes designated in the following subsections:

* * * *

- (q) Bay Area Law Enforcement Assistance Fund, for the payment of money to.
- (r) San Francisco Firefighter and EMS Behavioral Health Foundation, for the payment of money to.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
