3	Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment to accept and expend a			
4	grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District			
5	Transportation Fund to collaborate with the San Francisco Bike Coalition and the			
6	Metropolitan Transportation Commission on the development of a web-based point-to-			
7	point bicycle route planning tool called Bikelnsight.

9	WHEREAS, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has awarded funds to the			
10	Department of the Environment to collaborate with the San Francisco Bike Coalition and the			
11	Metropolitan Transportation Commission on the development of a web-based point-to-point			
12	bicycle route planning tool called Bikelnsight; and,			
13	WHEREAS, the San Francisco Bike Coalition's mission is to transform San Francisco's			
14	streets and neighborhoods into safer, more livable places by promoting the bicycle for			
15	everyday transportation; and,			
16	WHEREAS, polls of San Francisco show that nearly half of adults own bicycles, but			
17	only 2-4% use them for commuting; and,			
18	WHEREAS, one of the biggest stated obstacles potential bike commuters face is			
19	finding the safest, easiest route from one place to another in the Bay Area; and,			
20	WHEREAS, BikeInsight will encourage greater numbers of people to choose biking as			
21	a means of everyday transportation by providing detailed route information; and,			
22	WHEREAS, a .01% increase in commuter bicycle use regionally could save 1,664 auto			
23	commute trips every weekday: and,			
24	WHEREAS, automobile emissions are a source of green house gases; and			
25	WHEREAS, decreasing auto commute trips will decrease automobile emissions; and,			

1	WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission will provide appropriate				
2	technical data and staff time as an in-kind contribution to help build BikeInsight; and,				
3	WHEREAS, the grant budget includes provision for administrative costs of \$10,000;				
4	now, therefore, be it				
5	RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the				
6	Department of the Environment to accept and expend \$200,000 from the Bay Area Air Quality				
7	Management District Transportation Fund to collaborate with the San Francisco Bike Coalition				
8	and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission on the development of a web-based point-				
9	to-point bicycle route planning tool called Bikelnsight.
