13	(a) Establishment of Fund. The Administrative Services Vehicle Leasing Program Fund is
14	established as a category six fund for the purpose of receiving funds work-ordered or transferred to the
15	<u>Department of Administrative Services by City departments for the use, maintenance, and replacement</u>
16	of City-owned general purpose vehicles, in accordance with the City's comprehensive fleet
17	management program and Administrative Code Section 4.10-1.
18	(b) Use of the Fund. Money or property received into the fund shall be used exclusively for
19	maintaining and replacing general purpose vehicles and for administering the vehicle leasing program.
