

1 [Grant to support the Peer Provider Project.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively funds from the California Wellness Foundation in the amount**
5 **of \$225,000 to support the Peer Provider Project, including a contract with Huckleberry**
6 **Youth Programs in the total amount of \$59,400; for the period of July 1, 2008 through**
7 **June 30, 2011.**

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9 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from the California Wellness Foundation for
10 \$225,000 to fund the Peer Provider Project, for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30,
11 2011; and,

12 WHEREAS, The goal is to reduce teen pregnancy rates in San Francisco County by
13 supporting the implementation of a pilot peer provider training offering direct service
14 experience to high school Juniors and Seniors interested in entering the health field; and,

15 WHEREAS, Contractual funds in the amount of \$59,400 will go to Huckleberry Youth
16 Programs, which will set up, facilitate and monitor the payment of stipends to youth
17 participating in the Peer Provider Project; and,

18 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds the California Wellness Foundation
19 requires DPH to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the
20 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 081054, which is hereby declared to be a part of
21 this resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses DPH for
23 two existing positions, including an Assistant Health Educator (Job Class #2819) at .20 FTE,
24 and a Registered Nurse (Job Class #2320) at .20 FTE; and,

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1 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
2 \$7,158; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
4 in the amount of \$225,000 from the California Wellness Foundation; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
6 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
8 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
9 be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
11 funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when
12 the agreement expires.
