6 WHEREAS, John Barleycorn Pub has been a neighborhood and citywide institution for
7 nearly 40 years; and

9 WHEREAS, John Barleycorn Pub, with its authentic cable car benches, church pews
10 from Old St. Mary's, and other historic memorabilia and furnishings, preserves a sense of Old
11 San Francisco; and

13 WHEREAS, John Barleycorn Pub has received accolades from around the world as a
14 unique San Francisco establishment; and

16 WHEREAS, John Barleycorn Pub has served as a community gathering place and
17 anchor for the social life of the neighborhood of Lower Nob Hill; and

19 WHEREAS, John Barleycorn Pub is the type of small, owner-operated business that is
20 acknowledged to be the most beneficial to the local economy and most responsive to community
21 concerns; and

23 WHEREAS, Sam Duvall and Lawrence Ayre, founders and operators of the Barleycorn
24 and other popular establishments, are recognized for their contributions to the cultural,
25 economic and social life of the city; now, therefore, be it

27 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors extends its highest commendation to John
28 Barleycorn Pub and calls on the owner of the property at 1415 Larkin Street to work
29 cooperatively to find a solution that would allow John Barleycorn Pub to remain a part of San
30 Francisco's cultural heritage.
