

1 CONCURRING WITH THE CONTROLLER'S CERTIFICATION THAT LEGAL PROCESS  
 2 SERVER SERVICES CAN BE PRACTICALLY PERFORMED FOR THE DISTRICT  
 3 ATTORNEY, FAMILY SUPPORT BUREAU, BY A PRIVATE CONTRACTOR FOR A LOWER  
 4 COST THAN SIMILAR SERVICES PERFORMED BY CITY AND COUNTY EMPLOYEES.

 6 WHEREAS, the electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition J  
 7 in November, 1976, (now Section 10.104.15 of the Charter) allowing City Departments to  
 8 contract with private companies for specific services which can be practically performed for a  
 9 lower cost than similar work by City and County employees; and,

10 WHEREAS, the District Attorney, Family Support Bureau, has sought and received  
 11 estimates from a private contractor and wishes to contract for legal process server services and,

12 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified on March 30, 1999, that said services can be  
 13 performed at a lower cost to the City and County by private contractor than by employees of the  
 14 City and County; NOW THEREFORE, be it

 16 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's  
 17 Certification and approves and authorizes the District Attorney, Family Support Bureau, to  
 18 contract for legal process server services.


