3 **Motion approving/rejecting the Mayor's nomination for the reappointment of Kate Stacy**
4 **to the Public Utilities Commission, for a term ending August 1, 2030.**

6 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Charter, Section 4.112, Mayor Daniel Lurie has submitted a
7 communication notifying the Board of Supervisors of the nomination for the reappointment of
8 Kate Stacy to seat 4 on the Public Utilities Commission, received by the Clerk of the Board on
9 June 5, 2026; and

10 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 4.112, requires that seat 4 shall be a member with
11 expertise in water systems, power systems or public utility management, appointed by the
12 Mayor and subject to confirmation by a majority of the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore,
13 be it

14 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves/rejects the Mayor's
15 nomination for the reappointment of Kate Stacy, seat 4, succeeding herself, to the Public
16 Utilities Commission, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term beginning August 1, 2026,
17 and ending August 1, 2030.
