2 Engineers, Local 21]

3 **Ordinance adopting and implementing Amendment No. 3 to the 2014-2019**
4 **Memorandum of Understanding between the City and County of San Francisco and the**
5 **International Federation of Professional and Technical Engineers, Local 21, by adding:**
6 **a one-time base wage increase of 6.40% to Classification 8240 Public Safety**
7 **Communications Coordinators, effective July 1, 2018; and \$150,000 in training funds**
8 **for FY2018-2019 only, for total training funds for that year of \$900,000.**

16 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

17 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts and implements Amendment No. 3
18 to the 2014-2019 Memorandum of Understanding between the City and County of San
19 Francisco and the International Federation of Professional and Technical Engineers, Local 21,
20 by adding: (a) a one-time base wage increase of 6.40% to Classification 8240 Public Safety
21 Communications Coordinators, effective July 1, 2018; and (b) \$150,000 in training funds for
22 fiscal year 2018-2019 only, for total training funds for that year of \$900,000.

23 Amendment No. 3 to the MOU so implemented is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
24 Supervisors in Board File No. 180514.

25 Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Human
Resources to make non-substantive ministerial or administrative corrections to the MOU.

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Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor’s veto of the ordinance.
