7 WHEREAS, San Francisco's renowned Halloween celebration located in the Civic
8 Center and Castro attracts residents from neighborhoods throughout the city and tourists from
9 all over the world, the nation and the Bay Area; and,

10 WHEREAS, The celebration ends at 2:00 a.m. on November 1, at which time
11 thousands of people are in need of safe, affordable, efficient means of transportation to their
12 homes; and,

13 WHEREAS, Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) provides one such alternative and serves
14 the entire Bay Area; and,

15 WHEREAS, Extending BART service until 1:30 a.m. would encourage more people to
16 use public transit, reduce traffic congestion and increase safety; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges
18 Bay Area Rapid Transit to extend its service to 1:30 a.m. on November 1, 1999 to
19 accommodate increased need for and usage of public transportation for this year's Halloween
20 celebration in San Francisco.


