TRANSBAY JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY

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Authority:

Government Code Section 6502 whereby the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 104-01 authorizing the formation of the Transbay Joint Powers Authority and to make said appointments.

Board Qualifications:

The Transbay Joint Powers Authority consists of a total of a six-member board of directors, one of whom is a member of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors appointed by the Board of Supervisors and one member appointed by the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors subject to affirmative confirmation by the Board of Supervisors. The composition of the other members are as follows: one member appointed by the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board-Caltrain (JPB); one member appointed by AC Transit; one member appointed by the Mayor of San Francisco; and one ex-officio member appointed by the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

The Transbay Joint Powers Authority (also known as the TJPA) with the City, AC Transit, and the JPB as members will develop, design, construct, and operate a new transit terminal and related facilities on and adjacent to the existing Transbay Terminal site. TJPA shall have authority to issue bonds and other evidences of indebtedness to help finance such purposes.
