

1 [Accept-Expend Regional Grant]

2 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO ACCEPT AND  
3 EXPEND \$899,250 FROM THE TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR VEHICLES;  
4 AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO EXECUTE  
5 AGREEMENTS WITH THE BAY AREA AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT WHEREBY  
6 THE CITY WOULD INDEMNIFY THE DISTRICT FROM CLAIMS RESULTING FROM THE  
7 CITY'S PERFORMANCE OF SAID AGREEMENTS.

8 WHEREAS, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District ("District")  
9 has approved \$899,250 from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air, for  
10 the Department of Administrative Services to implement the following  
11 clean air vehicle projects:

12 Natural Gas Vehicle Demonstration- 45 Light Duty Vehicles

13 To fund the incremental costs of replacing 45 gasoline vehicles  
14 with compressed natural gas vehicles;

15 Electric Vehicle Demonstration- 17 Light Duty Vehicles

16 To fund the incremental costs of replacing 17 gasoline vehicles  
17 with electric vehicles;

18 Natural Gas Vehicle Demonstration- 2 Heavy Duty Vehicles

19 To fund incremental costs of replacing two gasoline recycling  
20 trucks operated by Norcal Waste Systems, Inc. with compressed  
21 natural gas vehicles;

22 Natural Gas Vehicle Taxi Demonstration- 30 Light Duty Vehicles

23 To offer funding incentives to taxicab owners to replace 30 light  
24 duty gasoline powered taxicabs with compressed natural gas  
25 taxicabs; and

1           WHEREAS, the District requires that the City enter into funding  
2 agreements in order to receive the funds to be used for these  
3 projects; and


4           WHEREAS, the District requires that the City shall indemnify and  
5 hold harmless the Air District, its officers, employees, agents,  
6 representatives, and successors-in-interest against any and all  
7 claims, suits, or actions resulting from the performance by the City  
8 of its duties under the agreements; now, therefore be it

9           RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the  
10 Director of Administrative Services to accept and expend \$899,250 from  
11 the Transportation Fund for Clean Air; and be it

12           FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes  
13 the Director of Administrative Services to enter into agreements with  
14 the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, which agreements may  
15 provide for the City to indemnify and hold harmless the Air District,  
16 its officers, employees, agents, representatives, and successors-in-  
17 interest against any and all claims, suits, or actions resulting from  
18 the performance by the City of its duties under the agreements.




