AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$899,250 FROM THE TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR VEHICLES; AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE BAY AREA AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT WHEREBY THE CITY WOULD INDEMNIFY THE DISTRICT FROM CLAIMS RESULTING FROM THE CITY'S PERFORMANCE OF SAID AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District ("District") has approved \$899,250 from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air, for the Department of Administrative Services to implement the following clean air vehicle projects:

Natural Gas Vehicle Demonstration- 45 Light Duty Vehicles

To fund the incremental costs of replacing 45 gasoline vehicles with compressed natural gas vehicles;

Electric Vehicle Demonstration- 17 Light Duty Vehicles

To fund the incremental costs of replacing 17 gasoline vehicles with electric vehicles;

Natural Gas Vehicle Demonstration- 2 Heavy Duty Vehicles

To fund incremental costs of replacing two gasoline recycling trucks operated by Norcal Waste Systems, Inc. with compressed natural gas vehicles;

Natural Gas Vehicle Taxi Demonstration- 30 Light Duty Vehicles

To offer funding incentives to taxicab owners to replace 30 light duty gasoline powered taxicabs with compressed natural gas

taxicabs; and

Supervisors Ammiano, Teng, Bierman

WHEREAS, the District requires that the City enter into funding agreements in order to receive the funds to be used for these projects; and

WHEREAS, the District requires that the City shall indemnify and hold harmless the Air District, its officers, employees, agents, representatives, and successors-in-interest against any and all claims, suits, or actions resulting from the performance by the City of its duties under the agreements; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Administrative Services to accept and expend \$899,250 from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Administrative Services to enter into agreements with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, which agreements may provide for the City to indemnify and hold harmless the Air District, its officers, employees, agents, representatives, and successors-in-interest against any and all claims, suits, or actions resulting from the performance by the City of its duties under the agreements.
